



Neighborhood Camera Rebate Program Application

The Program

For a limited time, the City is offering a Camera Rebate for residents and businesses. The maximum rebate of up to \$150.00 per residential property and up to \$250.00 for businesses within the City Limits of the City of Wasco and are subject to the conditions outlined below.

Public safety is a priority for City Council and it is believed the addition of security cameras to businesses and residences will support law enforcement, deter criminal activity and contribute to the overall safety and security in the community.

Who is eligible for the program?

This offer is only for businesses or residential properties located within the city limits of the City of Wasco. Security camera systems must be installed on the exterior of the home/building facing the public right of way (sidewalk, street, alley). Rebates will be issued on a first-come, first-served basis, accepting only valid applications for **security cameras purchased on or after January 1, 2021**, until the funding is exhausted.

Residential: For first qualified, functioning, and registered camera the rebate is up to \$100.00 or 50% of the cost of the camera if cost is less than \$100.00. For second camera, the rebate is up to \$50.00 or 50% of the cost of the camera if cost is less than \$50.00.

Business: Located within the City limits of the City of Wasco and possess a current City of Wasco Business license may qualify for up to \$250.00 rebate or 50% of the cost of the camera system if cost of the camera is less than \$250.00.

The City of Wasco will issue a rebate check to the applicant based on the application requirements. All applications are subject to verification and approval.

Requirements

1. Completed application form (on reverse).
Proof of installation as follows:
2. Receipt dated on or after January 1, 2021 for purchase of a security camera from a
 Photograph of camera installed
 Photograph of still image of their camera's view. *Must face the Public Right of Way (sidewalk, street, alley)
 Information regarding the camera brand, model, specifications, serial number and MAC address
3. Confirmation email from Kern County Sheriff's Office as receipt of camera registration.
Camera registry must remain active for at least 24 months.

We recommend making a copy of your completed application package for your own records, as all information submitted will not be returned.
